- This fireplace is not intended for use in bathrooms, laundry areas and similar indoor locations. Never locate fireplace where it may fall into a bathtub or other water container.
- Do not run cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Arrange cord away from traffic area and where it will not be tipped over.
- To disconnect fireplace, turn controls to off, then remove plug from outlet.
- Use this fireplace only as describes in this manual. Any other use not recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Replacement of the lamps should be done only while the fireplace is disconnected from the supply circuit.




This product includes a **GLASS panel!** Always use **extreme caution** when handling **glass.** Failure to do so could result in **personal injury** or **property damage**.





Installation and Assembly

RECESSED TO WALL INSTALLATION





STEP A. Selection a dry wall to open a hole for fireplace box. Size of hole as below chart **Figure (A)**

STEP B. Fix the wall anchors in each side of the fireplace box according to the dimensions showed on the drawing. **Figure (B)**


<u>NOTE:</u> The appliance tabs come bent. You must bend the tab flat by hand when fully recessing the appliance into the wall.






STEP C. Take off the screw in both sides of the top fireplace box. Figure (C)

STEP D. Have two person to take the glass panel out of the fireplace box. Place it to a soft and clean place. **Figure (D)**



STEP E. Take off the two screws in both sides, then take off the two metal brackets, keep them well as you will need to screw back .have two people lift the fireplace and recessed it to the wall opening hole **Figure (E, F)**



Wall Mounted Installation

Due to the many different materials used on different walls, it is highly recommended that you consult your local builder before you install this appliance on the wall.

A.Select a location that is not prone to moisture and is located at least 36" (914mm) away from combustible materials such as curtain drapes, furniture, bedding, paper, etc.

B. Have two people hold the appliance against the wall to determine the final location.

C.Place unit face down on a soft, non abrasive surface. Remove the bracket from the back of the unit by removing the screws, refer to Figure 1.

D.Mark out location, then mount the bracket(s) onto the wall using the supplied screws. This bracket

MUST have the hooks facing upward and be level. NOTE: It is strongly

recommended that the mounting bracket (E) be Screwed into the wall studs Where possible. If the wall Studs cannot be used, ensure




That the supplied plastic anchors are used to affix the bracket to the wall and the bracket is adequately secured.

E. With the wall mounting bracket installed have two people lift the appliance up and insert the two hooks

on the bracket into the two slots on the back of the appliance.

F. Check the appliance for stability ensuring that the bracket will not pull free from the wall.

Log-set / Crystals/Pebbles Installation

(NOTE:Please make the installation according to the embers which you bought or selected.)

- **A.** Glass front must be removed and the appliance must be mounted in its final location before the drift logs embers are installed.
- **B.** Carefully place the plastic ember bed strip to the slot, then place crystal/pebbles embers onto the surface of the ember bed as illustrated. Apply an even layer from side to side. **Figure 1**, **Figure 2**.


Power

Plug the power cord into a AC 220-240 Volt outlet (see **IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION** on **Pages 2 and 3**). Make sure the outlet is in good condition and that the plug is not loose. **NEVER** exceed the maximum amperage for the circuit. **DO NOT** plug other appliances into the same circuit.

This electric fireplace can be operated ONLY by the REMOTE CONTROL.



Remote Control

Remote Control Operation

BUTTON	FUNCTION	ACTION & INDICATION	
(1)	ON : Enables control panel functions and remote control. Turns on flame effect.	Press once. Indicator light turns on. Power turns on. All functions enabled.	
POWER	OFF : Disables control panel functions and remote control. Turns off flame effect.	Press again. Flame effect turns off. Unit goes to standby. All functions turn off.	
SPEED	Flame speed button: Controls the speed of the flame. There are 4 flame speed settings: 01 (slowest), 02 (Medium), 03 (fast), 04(fastest)	 Press once. Flame speed gets changing. Press again until desired setting is reached. Display shows the setting. The Default setting is 02 (medium speed) 	





To improve operation, **aim** the remote control at the front of the fireplace. **DO NOT press the buttons too quickly**. Give the unit time to respond to each command.

Remote Control Battery Information

Remote control uses one CR2025 battery (Included)

Care and Maintenance

Cleaning



ALWAYS turn the fireplace **OFF** and **unplug the power cord from the outlet** before cleaning, performing maintenance, or moving this fireplace. Failure to do so could result in **electric shock**, **fire**, **or personal injury**.



NEVER immerse in water or **spray with water**. Doing so could result in **electric shock**, **fire**, **or personal injury**.

Metal:

- Buff using a soft cloth, slightly dampened with a citrus oil-based product.
- **DO NOT** use brass polish or household cleaners as these products will damage the metal trim.

Glass:

- Use a good quality glass cleaner sprayed onto the cloth or towel. Dry thoroughly with a paper towel or lint-free cloth.
- **NEVER** use abrasive cleansers, liquid sprays, or any cleaner that could scratch the surface.

Vents:

Use a vacuum or duster to remove dust and dirt from the fireplace and vent areas.

Plastic:

- Wipe gently with a slightly damp cloth and a mild solution of dish soap and warm water.
- **NEVER** use abrasive cleansers, liquid sprays, or any cleaner that could scratch the surface.

Maintenance



Risk of electric shock! DO NOT OPEN any panels! No user-serviceable parts inside!
